Meals delivered only to shut-ins, Dells Nursing and Rehab, Orchard Hills, and Friendship Villages. All workers pay for their meals. Workers may purchase carry-out tickets to take meals home.

**Individual Instructions:**

- You can donate as much as you like to the kitchen and country store/candy booth.
- **Each member** is asked to bring an envelope with the following information on the front of the envelope. Example on separate sheet.
  - Name, group name, current phone number and email address.
  - List donations and donation value.
  - Add any additional money owed to a donation value of \$25.00. If **adding annual dues for your group please make a separate check to your group.**
  - Place money owed in the envelope. Make checks payable to St. Mary Altar Society.
  - Please seal the envelope and turn it in to the Food Checkers located in the school lunchroom or church hall foyer.
- If **any worker finds it impossible to work**, he or she is responsible to find their own replacement. Please notify one of the officers of any changes.
- Each worker must pick up their name tag located at their work station and stay until they are replaced. No worker shall be excused to eat during their shift. You are responsible for cleaning up your area when you are finished.
- **Each Chairperson of a work committee** is responsible for seeing that the necessary equipment is on hand to work with large kettles, sharp knives, etc. **Each Chairperson needs to call your committee shift workers and remind** them when and where they are to work, especially if they are new to your committee.
- **Each Group Leader must deliver** Bazaar schedule to all members in their group so they are aware of their work schedule, unless they have requested to receive this via email.
- **DOUBLE CHECK YOUR JOB, LOCATION, AND TIME, IT MAY HAVE CHANGED!**

**Instructions for Kitchen, Country Store/Candy Booth donations:**

- All items for the Country Store/Candy Booth must be labeled and priced by the person making the donation.
- All donations should be to the church hall and school lunchroom by 10 AM Sunday September 15<sup>th</sup>.

### Instructions for Groups:

- **EACH Group** will furnish:
  - 7 large roasting/deep pans (not electric or aluminum roasters) for roasting turkeys (20-22lbs). Have them at the school lunchroom by 12:00 Noon Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>. **Do not bring lids. Mark them so they can be returned to the owner.**
  - 26 large, homemade pies, 8 cream pies (**deliver to Church Hall ONLY**), 5 apple, 5 pumpkin, 8 fruit (other than apple). **PLEASE LABEL ALL PIES.**
  - Sweet Treat Walk 15 @ \$5.00 each ***Please take these items to the gym.***
    - Cake, Bars, Cupcakes (12)(NO PIES)
  - 2 dozen cupcakes or 1 pan kid-friendly bars
  - 1 pan dessert (no refrigerator desserts)
  - 1 diabetic dessert
  - **\*\*Disposable pie tins are preferred, label your pans, not responsible for missing pans\*\***
  - 35 quarts of corn. No bigger than quart size- completely defrosted .Deliver corn to church hall kitchen.
